## To ensure the health and safety of our sailing community and everyone's enjoyment of the sailing season please ensure that you are aware and comply with the Club's COVID Safe guidance.

- Members are not permitted to enter the Club or come to the Club for sailing if:
  - You have been in Victoria or attended a NSW hot spot venue in the last 14 days (as listed on <u>NSW Govt site</u>)
  - Are awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test
  - $\circ$  Have been in close contact with anyone who is covered by the items above
  - You have any COVID-19 symptoms or feel unwell

NOTE: The above applies to all senior and junior members. "The Club" includes decks, bistro and boatshed.

- COVID Safe Hygiene Practices and Social Distancing must be adhered to as much as practical while rigging and using all areas of the Club.
- Standing and drinking is not allowed. Whether you have bought your own or purchased at the club please be seated while eating & drinking.
- The Club requests that change room usage be kept to a minimum. Maximum change room capacity at any time is MENS 4 persons & LADIES 2 persons.
- Crews are not able to social distance while sailing a skiff or dinghy meaning that all of the above requirements become even more important when ashore!
- Rescue and start boats capacities are determined by the 4sqm rule meaning that rescue boats should carry no more than 2 people and social distancing on board should be adhered to as much as practical.
- When arriving at the Club for sailing everyone (sailors, parents, volunteers, etc) must signin/register. SENIOR SAILING: sign in via bar/bistro machines. JUNIOR SAILING: instructions to be provided by the Junior President.
- Australian Sailing has provided recommendations regarding covid safe operations based on guidance from NSW Health. In summary it recommends that all crews sailing on boats at MH16's should be residents of Zone A. Please review the details and maps via -<u>https://www.sailingresources.org.au/covid-19/</u>.
